FILING FOR MUNICIPAL OFFICE

Residents are reminded that the City's next municipal election will be held on Tuesday, November 5th. Parties wishing to file for municipal office may do so at the City Clerk's Office beginning today, through Monday, September 16th, between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM. The filing fee to run for Mayor or member of City Council is \$5.00; Ward Official is \$1.00.

Filings will be taken for the office of Mayor, Ward Councilor, Councilor-At-Large, Ward Moderator, Ward Clerk, and Supervisor of the Checklist. LOUDON ROAD WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT

Next week, the contractor plans to install some new hydrants, connect water services over to the new water main from East Side Drive to Gates Street, and flush and test the water main from Woodcrest Heights Road to Old Loudon Road.

WATER MAIN SHUTDOWN

As part of the Loudon Road water system improvement project, the City will need to temporarily shut down the water main on Allard Street, from Loudon Road to Branch Turnpike Road, beginning at 9:00 PM on Sunday night, September 8th, until 6:00 AM on Monday, September 9th. All affected residents have been notified.

PENACOOK UTILITY INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

Next week, drainage and sewer manhole installations will occur in the vicinity of Sanders Street and Village Street. Liberty Utilities will begin tying in gas services between Meter Street and Coral Street, and has begun the work across the bridge as well.
