CONCORD, NH - On January 29, 2014 at approximately 4:30 PM it was reported to police that someone had stolen a debit card and used it at two local businesses. The victim reported that he had lost his wallet while walking from UNH Law School to the area of 16-22 North Spring Street. It is believed that the wallet was lost at some point between 8:00 AM and 12:00 PM on January 29th.

The wallet was later recovered; however the victim noticed that his debit card, credit card, and driver's license were missing. After discovering this, the victim called the Bank of America and was told that debit card had been used twice.



The card was used at the Shaw's grocery store, located on Ft. Eddy Rd. on January 29, 2014 at 1220 PM for the approximate amount of \$112.00. Someone attempted to use the card a second time at the Hannaford's grocery store on Ft. Eddy Rd. at 12:33 PM for the approximate amount of \$117.00.

Police responded to Hannaford's and secured video of the suspect making a purchase with the victim's card. According to store records, the items purchased by the suspect included a gift card, rotisserie chicken, pure leaf raspberry tea and a lemon tea.

The suspect is described as a white male wearing a red shirt, black pants, and sunglasses.

Police have recovered video surveillance from store security and is asking the public to assist in identifying the person of interest depicted in the photographs.
