Winter Operations



Crews plow and treat the 220 miles of streets in Concord on a [priority service level](#) during the winter. Once snow removal operations are completed for city streets, our crews can focus on clearing the 90 miles of sidewalk throughout the city on a [priority level basis](#). Downtown areas and designated school routes are the first priority, followed by major arterial streets. Downtown sidewalks are the only sidewalks cleared on overtime. All other sidewalks, including designated school routes, are plowed during normal business hours (6:30am to 3:00pm).
